- **State Championship volunteer rule:** Clubs within a 200km radius of the Brisbane GPO who have members competing at any State Championship event in the SE corner of Qld must provide one Volunteer for the duration of the event. Failure to comply with this rule will result in non-start for effected club members. Please contact your club secretary to ensure this rule is adhered to.
